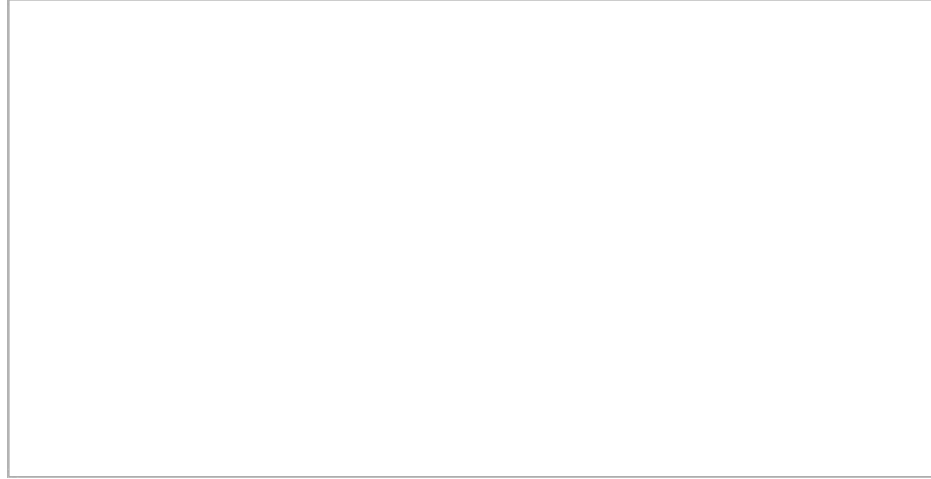


## Latest news for the system
